#### **Note 1: Accounting Policies**

#### **Basis of Preparation**

The financial statements for the Kapiti Coast Hockey Club, including the Kapiti Coast Junior Hockey Club have been prepared on a cash basis.

Kapiti Coast Hockey Club is not GST registered. Accordingly, all amounts included in the financial statements are reported inclusive of GST.

We received a \$22,015 Community Resilience grant from Sport NZ in September 2020. This fund formed part of the COVID-19 relief fund to provide assistance to Community Sports that were affected by the COVID-19 outbreak. This fund will be utilised over the next 3 years to subside hockey fees for all club members. We've used \$6,048 of this Grant towards subs this season.

Some grant allocations are predetermined by the Grantee to cover certain costs which include but are not limited to, administration and coaching fees, equipment, uniforms and affiliation fees.
